We'll start with the basic tools I use in my journals – pens, pencil, and watercolor – and as the weeks progress, I hope you'll add your own favorite tools and colors. You don't have to be an expert at drawing or lettering or layout to take this class. Each of us will start right where we are, and learn by doing. The most important thing to bring to class is your willingness to pour out your heart on to the page. It is that, more than your artistic skill, which will give your journal its value, and make it uniquely yours.

Supply List

- · A sheet of Arches Text Wove <u>or</u> watercolor paper cut into eighths <u>or</u> a journal with paper suited to wet media (meaning it won't bleed or soak through)
- \cdot 0.5mm mechanical pencil and a good eraser Mono Zero is one I like.
- ·Ruler
- · Watercolors any old pan set will do!
- · Kemper Fluid Writer (Amazon has them). There are two sizes available either is fine, but the larger one might be easier to work with.
- · Pointed pen of your choice just not super sharp. Nikko G, EF66, Globe pen...whatever you already have. If you don't use pointed pens, you could also use a Speedball B6 or a Brause 1mm or smaller.
- · Pointed brush size 2 or larger
- · Waterproof black pen: Black Pigma Micron 01 or 005 <u>or</u> similarly sized Copic Multiliner <u>or</u> Platinum Carbon Pen
- · UniBall Signo White gel pen or Sakura Gelly Roll
- · water container
- · Gel pens, if you have some. If you don't and want to get some, I like the Sakura Moonlight 06 series and UniBall Signo brands, because they color well and come in small line widths.
