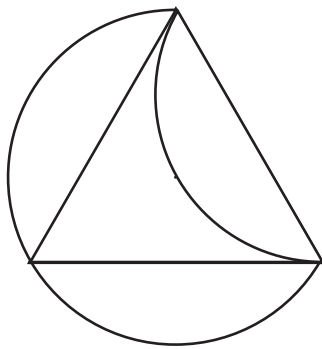
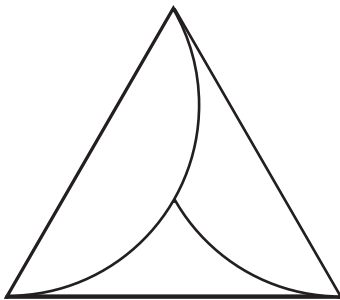


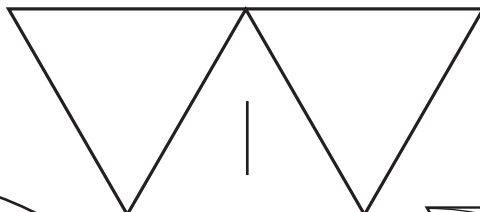
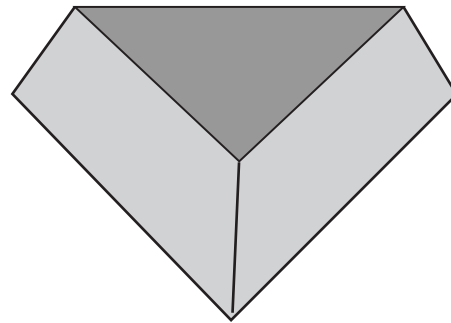
Triangle Box



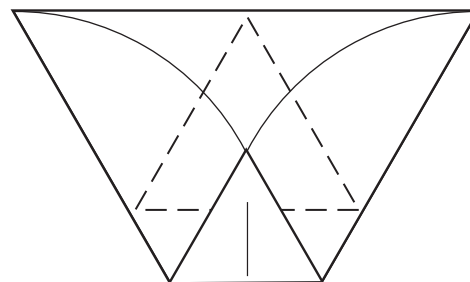
1. Cut an 8" circle (or any size you like). Mark the center.
2. Fold one edge of the circle to the center point.
3. From one end of the fold you just made, fold a second edge of the circle to the center. This will create a 60 degree angle.



4. Fold the remaining edge as you did the first two, from the ends of your first two folds to the center point. You now have an equilateral triangle in the center of your circle.



5. Fold one point of the triangle to the crease on the opposite edge.
6. Repeat with the other two points.
7. Fold each of the three points to the center. Each point now has two folds across it.



8. Find the pocket formed by the edge of the circle in one of the three points.
9. Tuck the point beside it into the pocket.
10. Fill your box.
11. Tuck the remaining point into the box. It may not stay shut easily.
